Student Cultural and Academic Exchange Visit to Stuttgart, Germany in December 2019

Concept

Six Kyutech students visit Stuttgart University and the Stuttgart region in Germany for **two weeks**. The goal of this exchange is to make the students familiar with the research conducted at the host institute, introduce them to the style of teaching, learning and student life at Stuttgart University as well as introduce some major sights, companies and the culture of the Stuttgart Region.

The activities are divided into three types:

- Academic Program
- Cultural Exchange Program
- Free-Time for own activities

The **Academic Program** consists of

- Short seminar challenge in which each student prepares a short presentation about a current research publication from the visited university.
- A student seminar in which each student reports on his/her own research activities.
- A research seminar with talks on advanced topics from faculty members and phd students from both sides.
- Lecture visits at Stuttgart University. Students are free to choose ongoing lectures in the English language to visit. A schedule of lectures will be provided.
- Student progress meetings with advisors and staff members to discuss ongoing experiences, progress and problems.

The **Cultural Exchange Program** is designed the show various aspects of German culture and the Stuttgart region as well as connecting students from Japan and Germany on a more personal level. We currently plan the following activities (subject to change):

- Several dinners at different, interesting restaurants
- City Tour of Stuttgart, Tübingen and Weil-der-Stadt
- Visit to Christmas Markets in Esslingen, Stuttgart and Weil-der-Stadt
- Factory tours to Daimler Benz and Sehne Bakery
- Visiting the Daimler Benz Museum, Porsche Museum, and Kepler Museum
- Student Social Exchange Party with Movies and Pizza

There is ample **Free-Time** given to students for their own exploration and activities. While part of their free time will be spend on the seminar challenge preparation and self-study, students are encouraged to propose, plan and conduct some activities on their own. Advisors and staff members will support the students where necessary.
